3. Restored Joy

"... the oil of joy instead of mourning...." Isaiah 61:3 (NIV, 2011)

"Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will rejoice, and no one will take away your joy." John 16:22 (NIV, 2011)

4. Restored Faith

"...a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair." Isaiah 61:3 (NIV, 2011)
